1. Were the original, specific aims of the proposal realized?

The goals of this proposal realized are the following:

- There is differential expression of critical genes and transcripts between right and left murine maxillo-mandibular complexes at E14.5.
- There is differential expression of genes and transcripts with significant constraint scores and GO terms involving several important developmental events during embryogenesis.
- Many of these genes and transcripts have known associations with craniofacial phenotypes in mice and humans, including association with cleft lip \pm palate and craniofacial microsomia.
- These findings set a baseline for differential expression between maxillo-mandibular complexes at E14.5. Future studies are needed to confirm these findings.
