Summary/Abstract	This year has been very productive in terms of the development of my academic career. I have had several papers published or accepted for publication, and I have been invited to speak at the Northwest component of the Angle <i>Society</i> , as well as the PCSO meeting in Monterey this fall. I continue to serve on the editorial board of the Journal of Evidence-Based Dentistry, and several of my reviews have been published. I have attached a current copy of my biosketch for your review.
	The NIDCR K-22 Career Development Award that I applied for received a score of 231. This was slightly above the cutoff score, but I plan to revise the application and resubmit it in July. I also have applied for the K-12 Career Development Award in the Western
	Consortium. Hopefully, I will begin work on one of these projects by the end of 2002.
	I continue to be involved with three funded projects — Invisalign, interceptive orthodontic services in a Medicaid population, and TMD in adolescents. Additionally, I received an Award form the University of Washington to investigate the distribution of orthodontic services in Washington state. In particular, we wifi determine the amount of orthodontic services provided by general dentists, pedodontists, and orthodontists. I also continue to serve on several graduated student research committees. My teaching responsibilities for the graduate students have remained similar over the past year - I coordinate the graduate seminar one morning per week, and I serve as director of our Journal Club course. My undergraduate teaching responsibilities increased substantially this year, as I taught the major undergraduate orthodontic course. Also, I was invited to be an instructor this past April at the Tweed Course in Tucson.
